

Call LOPA within 1 hour

When a vented patient with a severe neurologic, life threatening injury requiring ventilator support AND meets any of the following (regardless of sedation):

- Loss of 2 or more brain stem reflexes (pupils, corneal, cough/gag, pain response, spontaneous breathing)
- **GCS 8 or less**
- Poor prognosis or non-survivable injury (anoxic brain injury, CVA, trauma)
- Hypothermic/TTM protocol
- End of life/goals of care discussions

 (hospice/palliative consults, code status changes, prior to withdrawal of life sustaining treatments or brain death testing)
- Family mention of donation
- Call LOPA with updates on an existing patient or unsure if patient meets criteria
- Always refer a patient before terminal extubation
- Avoid any conversations regarding donation with the family
