## CODE RED PROCEDURES

To report CODE RED, dial 6999 on nearest phone (off-site dial 911)

### AT THE SCENE

**R** = Rescue,  
**A** = Alert/Activate alarm systems,  
**C** = Containment and  
**E** = Extinguish/Evacuate

### PROPER USE OF FIRE EXTINGUISHER

**P** = Pull the pin.  
**A** = Aim the extinguisher at the base of the flames.  
**S** = Squeeze/depress the handle.  
**S** = Sweeping motion is used while directing the contents of the extinguisher at the base of the flames.

### You should know:

- Locations of nearest fire extinguishers and alarm pull boxes
- The fire location - room number and building
- All fire exits in your work area
