### AT THE SCENE

Rescue

Alarm

Contain

Extinguish/Evacuate

### PROPER USE OF FIRE EXTINGUISHER

Pull the Pin

Aim the extinguisher at base of fire while standing back 6-8 feet

Squeeze the handle firmly

Slowly sweep extinguisher from side to side starting with base of fire
