Lafayette is home to the only hospital solely dedicated to women and children. While the hospital continues to provide advanced care, its facilities must be improved to serve our patients better and support our team of healthcare professionals. We brought together a team of doctors, nurses and community leaders to help shape the next generation of Women's & Children's Hospital. We have studied best practices and conducted focus groups with stakeholders and national organizations.

Four decades of consistently delivering compassionate care have made Women's & Children's Hospital a nationally-recognized healthcare provider for patient satisfaction. However, as time passes and medical technology evolves, the physical structure of the hospital has become tired. The hospital's reputation has far outpaced the capacity of its facilities, which have strived to keep up with the expanding services and growing patient needs.

Women's & Children's Hospital is a healthcare facility with a rich history and strong foundation, ready to embrace modern advancements and improvements.


Patient visits have increased significantly since 1983.

Advancing Acadiana through transformative growth

Advancing Acadiana is our bold vision to meet the region's growing needs, enabling us to treat our patients in the right place, with the right resources, at the right time. It is specifically designed to enhance the quality of care and improve the patient experience. By 2026, we will have invested over \$100 million across all our campuses through construction projects, technological advancements, and process enhancements.

Our plan for Women's & Children's Hospital is a multi-phased renovation and expansion strategy that includes a state-of-the-art Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) with family suites, modernization of the labor and delivery experience, construction of a new Mother-Baby Unit, further development of our Women's Medical/Surgical Unit, a new chapel, and numerous other significant interior and exterior improvements.
